MOTION: I move that the board approve the execution of the Quit-Claim Deed as presented.
Recommendation: Approval of Action Requested.
Analysis: As part of the formation of Sewer District No. 9 the property owners of property upon which the treatment lagoon system was to be constructed deeded to the county, by a quit-claim deed dated January 22 nd 1999, that property. The lagoon system was later decommissioned and the county executed a quit-claim deed attempting to return the property to the surviving prior owner, that deed dated April 18, 2016. Unfortunately, the quit-claim deed named a trust as the transferee when, in fact, no such trust existed. That owner has since deceased and the property, through probate, is now the lawful property of two individuals who wish to sell the property.
A title search on the property has discovered the discrepancy created by the 2016 quit-claim deed and the attorneys for the owners are requesting that the county execute a new quit-claim deed to remedy the situation. Attached is (1) a letter from legal counsel for the owners explaining the matter; (2) Copies of the two prior deeds referenced above; (3) a copy of the probate ruling conferring ownership of the property to the two new owners, and (4) a proposed Quit-Claim Deed from the county to those two new owners, the purpose of which is to give them clear title.
Alternatives : Require the two new owners to file a Quiet Title action. This would be an unnecessary hardship upon them.

Our office represents Audra Raylene Dodd and Joyce Carlene Scott. I am contacting you on their behalf to hopefully resolve a title issue with a property they have inherited.

E. Joyce Evans ("Joyce") and her husband J.R. Evans, as joint tenants with rights of survivorship, owned the following real estate in Leavenworth County, Kansas:

A tract of land in the Northwest Quarter of Section 14, Township 11 South, Range 22 East of the 6th P.M., described as follows:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of Lot 47, Glenwood Estates Subdivision; thence South 70d31'19" West, 11.17 feet to the point of beginning of this tract; thence South 84d25'23" East. 325.00 feet; thence South 05d35'27" West, 564.00 feet; thence North 84d25'23" West, 325.00 feet; thence North 05d35'27" East. 564.00 feet to the point of beginning, less any part thereof taken or used for road purposes. Containing 4.2 acres more or less.

Parcel ID No. 52-186-14-0-00-00-029.15-0 (the "Lagoon")

On January 22, 1999, the Lagoon was transferred by quit claim deed to Leavenworth County Board of Commissioners. Exhibit A. Based on information from our clients, the heirs, the county was preparing to exercise its power of eminent domain over the Lagoon.

J.R. Evans passed away on April 13, 2010. <u>Exhibit B</u>. In 2016, the county transferred ownership back to Joyce, as surviving spouse and sole fee simple owner of the Lagoon.

However, when transferring the Lagoon back to the owner, the county listed the Grantee as "The Joyce E. Evans Trust." <u>Exhibit C</u>. Our office prepared Joyce's estate plan, and there has never been a Joyce E. Evans Trust.

Joyce passed on December 29, 2018. Our office assisted with probate administration of her estate under Leavenworth County District Court Case No. 2019-PR-000014. As set out in the Journal Entry of Final Settlement, all interest in real estate held by E. Joyce Evans at the time of her death was assigned to Audra Raylene Dodd and Joyce Carlene Scott. Exhibit D.

Now, while attempting to sell the property, our clients have discovered the underlying title issue concerning the Lagoon. To correct this issue, we are respectfully asking that the Board of County Commissioners execute either:

- (i) A Corrective Deed clarifying that the Kansas Quitclaim Deed dated April 18, 2016 and recorded as Doc No. 2016R-03053 transferred all interest held by the Board of County Commissioners to E. Joyce Evans, a widowed person, and not the Joyce E. Evans Trust;
- (ii) A Quitclaim Deed transferring all interest currently held by the Board of County Commissions in the Lagoon to Audra Raylene Dodd and Joyce Carlene Scott; or
- (iii) A Quitclaim Deed transferring all interest now held by the Board of County Commissioners in the Lagoon to the Estate of E. Joyce Evans, deceased.


