## RESOLUTION 2016 - 07

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LEAVENWORTH COUNTY, KANSAS, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. 8-1560, ESTABLISHING THE MAXIMUM SPEED OF 40 MILES PER HOURS FOR 195<sup>th</sup> STREET FROM AMELIA EARHART DRIVE (U.S. HIGHWAY 73 / KANSAS HIGHWAY 7) TO SANTA FE TRAIL (COUNTY ROUTE #14); REPEALING ANY PRIOR RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT FOR SAID SEGMENT OF ROAD/STREET.

WHEREAS, the Leavenworth Board of County Commissioners has the authority pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 8-1560 to establish maximum speed limits on roads and streets subject to the jurisdiction and control of the board, and

WHEREAS, no speed limit is currently posted along 195<sup>th</sup> Street between US-73/K-7 and Santa Fe Trail

WHEREAS, a geometric profile was complied and vertical alignment is consistent with a AASHTO design guidelines for *Geometric Design of Very-Low Volume Local Road (ADT*<400), 2001 edition of a 45 mile per hour maximum design speed.

WHEREAS, a speed study was conducted in February of 2016 that indicated the 85<sup>th</sup> Percentile Speed for this section of roadway was calculated at 48 miles per hour, and

WHEREAS, the completion of the engineering study, with concurring review by the County Engineer, the board has determined that the maximum speed limit for said road/street should be set at 40 miles per hour.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. The maximum speed limit for 195<sup>th</sup> Street between Amelia Earhart Drive (US 73 / K-7) and Santa Fe Trail (County Route 14) be set at 40 miles per hour.
- 2. That the Public Works Department is hereby instructed to immediately cause appropriate signage indicating the maximum speed limit along said road/street be installed and maintained.
- 3. That his resolution shall take effect upon the placement of said signage.
- 4. That any prior resolution establishing the maximum speed for said road/street is hereby repealed as it pertains to said road/street.
