## RESOLUTION 2016 - 29

RESOLUTION **OF** THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS LEAVENWORTH COUNTY, KANSAS, PUSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. 8-2008 AND OF K.S.A. 8-1560, ESTABLISHING THE PLACEMENT OF STOP SIGNS ITS INTERSECTIONS ROAD  $\mathbf{AT}$ WITH 182nd ON HATCHELL SIGNAGE AT REPEALING ANY PRIOR RESOLUTION GOVERNING LOCATION.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has the authority pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 8-2008 to effect the placement of regulatory stop signs.

WHEREAS, the placement of stop signs at this location is consistent with the currently adopted version of the MUTCD, and with standard traffic engineering practice.

WHEREAS, upon concurring review by the County Engineer, the board has determined that stop signs shall be placed on Hatchell Road at its intersection with 182nd Street.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. The traffic traveling East and West on Hatchell Road must stop prior to entering 182<sup>nd</sup> Street.
- 2. That the Director of Public Works is hereby instructed to immediately cause appropriate signage indicating that traffic must stop at this location be installed and maintained.
- 3. That this resolution shall take effect upon the placement of said signage.
- 4. That any prior resolution establishing traffic control at this location is hereby repealed as it pertains to said road/street.
