Wild teasel is another invasive species we try to control by chemical or mowing but unfortunately will lose this battle due to the fact it is mostly along state rights-of-way in large areas and rapidly spreading throughout the county, although the state was treating some areas last summer I have seen.

Another invasive species to be on the lookout for is Old World Blue Stem as it starts moving into the area.

Another species although not a noxious weed is the Braford pear Tree is an invasive tree species becoming a problem in the rights-of-way throughout the county which has already been banned in other states.

Action Requested: Approval of the minimum area for the FHWA Adjusted Urban Boundary in Leavenworth County.

Recommendation: Approval

Analysis: The FHWA requires the reclassification of roadways to Urban at the point that areas within a given census block reach a defined population density. The attached map shows the minimum area that has to be reclassified from rural to urban to meet the requirements set forth. MARC and KDOT had originally requested a much bigger area from Dempsey Road on the north to K-32 on the south to be reclassified. They felt that this area would meet the population density threshold within the next ten years when the next census data will be reported.

Basehor pushed back on this expanded map and county staff supports their position. Once a roadway is reclassified, it is no longer eligible for KDOT funding opportunities. All grant funding for the roadway must then be applied for through MARC. There is at least one High Risk Rural Roads Project on Fairmont Road that was identified in the Local Road Safety Plan that would no longer be eligible for KDOT funding and multiple city projects would be disqualified.

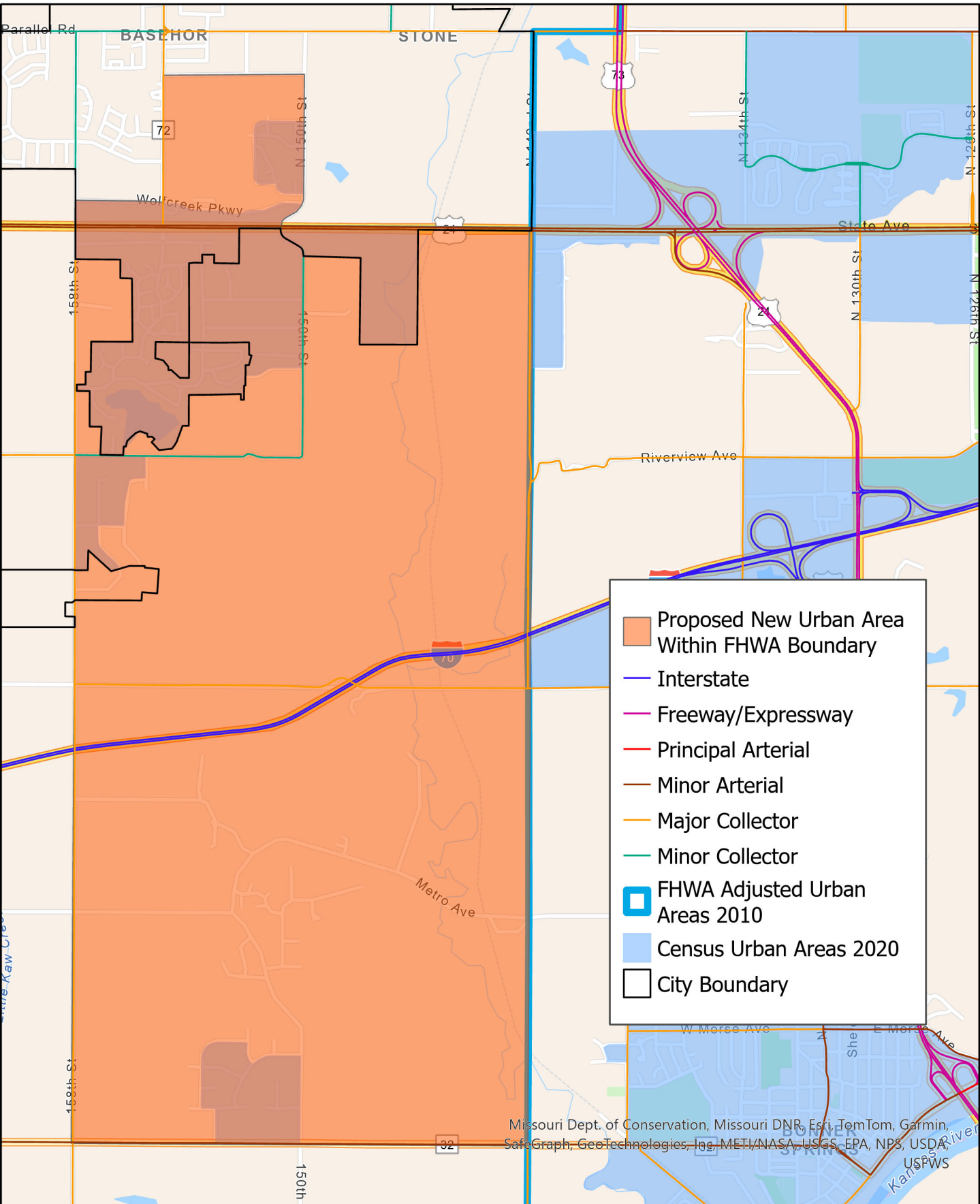
