LEAVENWORTH, Kan. --- On March 6, 2024, Emanuel Robinson, a 41-year-old Leavenworth County inmate who punched and kicked a fellow inmate, was sentenced to 32 months in the Kansas Department of Corrections for **Aggravated Battery**. Robinson will serve this 32-month sentence consecutive to all prior cases.

According to court records, on October 28, 2022, while inside the Leavenworth County Jail, Robinson battered his victim by using his feet and his fist. Following the incident, the victim was transported to a Kansas City area hospital for treatment. During the investigation, one witness reported that Robinson and the victim had been discussing a movie before Robinson struck the victim.

Leavenworth County Attorney Todd Thompson said, "Violence within the confines of jail will not be tolerated. My office is committed to pursuing prosecution if such incidents occur."
