LEAVENWORTH, Kans. --- A 49-year-old Leavenworth woman has been sentenced for attacking a mother and attempting to push a stroller with an infant inside into the roadway.

On Friday, November 22, 2024, Shalada L. Guerin, previously convicted of one count of **Aggravated Battery** in this case, was sentenced to 10 years in the Kansas Department of Corrections.

On March 16, 2024, Guerin approached a woman who was pushing a stroller with an infant near the 1700 block of 2nd Ave in Leavenworth, Kansas. Guerin physically attacked the woman and attempted to push the stroller, with the infant inside, into the roadway. A passerby stopped their vehicle and intervened, allowing the victim and her infant to escape to a nearby business. When Leavenworth police arrived, Guerin admitted to the attack. The woman suffered multiple injuries, including a broken nose, while her infant was not physically harmed.

Leavenworth County Attorney Todd Thompson said, "We hope the victim of this attack can continue to heal from the trauma she experienced. We are grateful that the infant was not physically harmed, and we would like to express our appreciation for the good Samaritan who intervened upon witnessing the wrongdoing."
