Bonner Springs Man Sentenced on Aggravated Assault Charge

LEAVENWORTH, Kan. --- A 30-year-old Bonner Springs man has been sentenced to 24 months in prison following a conviction for aggravated assault.

Kyle C. Hadley pleaded guilty on Nov. 26, 2025, to one count of aggravated assault with intent to commit any felony.

According to court documents, a Leavenworth County sheriff's deputy was dispatched on March 30, 2025, to a reported domestic disturbance at a residence in Linwood, Kansas. The victim told the deputy she was standing near her vehicle when Hadley pulled into the driveway in a manner she believed was intended to strike her with his truck.

The victim stated she feared for her life and believed Hadley was going to hit her with the vehicle. She reported that Hadley then exited the truck, began yelling and cursing, and eventually wrapped his arms around her.

The deputy later contacted a nearby resident who provided video footage that corroborated the victim's account, according to court records.

"We are deeply grateful to those who step forward to help others in need. We never want anyone to put themselves in harm's way, but having witnesses who are willing to document incidents and share evidence is critical to ensuring accountability and convictions," said Leavenworth County Attorney Todd G. Thompson.
