LEAVENWORTH, Kan. --- An 18-year-old man from Leavenworth has been arrested and charged with making a criminal threat that forced the temporary closure of a public pool in Leavenworth.

Landen W. Burgess was arrested Thursday and charged with aggravated criminal threat this morning.

Leavenworth County Attorney Todd Thompson said, “We take these matters seriously. Thanks to law enforcement for their hard work.”

Burgess is scheduled to appear before a Leavenworth County Judge today at 1 p.m. for his first appearance.

Any and all defendants are innocent until proven guilty. If a defendant is discussed within this email, they are innocent until proven guilty.
