LEAVENWORTH, Kan. --- A 36-year-old Leavenworth man has been sentenced to more than three years in prison for a child-related sex crime.

On Sept. 20, 2024, Nicholas Thomas Fuller was sentenced to **43 months in the Kansas Department of Corrections for Indecent Solicitation of a Child**.

According to court documents, Leavenworth police officers responded to a home near Muncie Road and Shrine Park Road on Aug. 20, 2022, after a juvenile called 911, reporting they had been sexually assaulted and needed help. Once contact was made with the victim on the scene; the victim told officers that Fuller had molested him inside a home and that it had happened several times before. The victim told officers that Fuller sat on his chest and asked for oral sex.

Leavenworth County Attorney Todd Thompson said, "My office remains committed to protecting the innocent and ensuring justice is served. These cases are difficult to all who are involved."

A jury found Fuller guilty of Indecent Solicitation of a Child on July 12, 2024.
