

Man pleads guilty to drug charges

LEAVENWORTH, Kan. --- A Lansing man found to have possessed more than 100 grams of methamphetamine has pleaded guilty to distribution or possession with intent to distribute methamphetamine and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Ryan Duane Case, 41, entered his pleas on Friday, May 12.

Case was taken into custody on the evening of December 7, 2022. Court documents state that Case was outside of his vehicle, at the intersection of 147th Street and McIntyre Road, when a law enforcement officer arrived. Case's vehicle had been involved in a single-vehicle rollover crash. While on the scene, it was determined that Case had possessed a backpack that contained more than 100 grams of methamphetamine.

Leavenworth County Attorney Todd Thompson said, "Thanks to our law enforcement friends, more dangerous drugs are off the street."

Sentencing is scheduled for June 23.
