LEAVENWORTH, Kan. --- A Leavenworth man, found to have a baggie of cocaine in his left sock following a domestic violence arrest, pled no contest Friday to one count each of domestic battery and possession of cocaine.

Willis L. Trodman, 61, was arrested on June 7, 2023, following a domestic disturbance inside an apartment near 1300 Stonleigh Court. While being booked into the Leavenworth County Jail, a small baggie containing several white powdery rocks was found in Trodman's left sock; upon discovering the baggie, Trodman volunteered that he had purchased crack.

After accepting the no-contest pleas, a judge found Trodman guilty on both charges and scheduled sentencing for November 3, 2023.

Leavenworth County Attorney Todd Thompson said, "Domestic violence and drug possession are serious crimes; we're thankful for the diligent work of our law enforcement officers for helping to protect our community."
