

BOARD ORDER 2020-3

AN ORDER OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF LEAVENWORTH, KANSAS, RELATING TO PUBLIC HEALTH, MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS AS AUTHORIZED BY THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. 48-925 AS AMENDED BY HB-2016 AND ISSUING ORDERS RELATING TO PUBLIC HEALTH

NOW ON THIS 2ND DAY OF JULY, 2020, the board of county commissioners of the county of Leavenworth, Kansas, meeting in special session, duly called, did consider the recently issued executive order of the governor of the state of Kansas, Executive Order NO. 20-52. Upon careful consideration of said order, and upon consultation with the local health officer and other local health officials regarding the governor's executive order enters the following findings:

1. That this board has consulted with the local health officer and other local health officials regarding the governor's executive order.
2. That upon careful consideration this board finds that the implementation of the full scope of the provisions in the governor's executive order are not necessary to protect the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the county of Leavenworth.
3. That upon the authority granted to them by the provisions of K.S.A. 48-925, as amended by HB 2016, enacted during the 2020 Special Session of the legislature of the state of Kansas, the board amends the executive order of the governor referenced above as follows:

That the wearing and use of face masks in public in the county of Leavenworth shall be recommended as a practice amenable to the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the county of Leavenworth, but that such wearing and use of face masks in public not be required or mandatory.

4. That the remaining provisions of the executive order of the governor, Order NO. 20-52, subject to the above amendment shall remain in full force and effect in Leavenworth county.
