LEAVENWORTH, Kan. --- The Leavenworth County Attorney's Office is aware of an incident involving an officer-involved shooting that occurred Saturday, Jan. 6, 2024, in downtown Leavenworth. The Kansas Bureau of Investigation is currently investigating the incident. This is an ongoing investigation; once the KBI completes its independent investigation into the shooting, the findings will be presented to the Leavenworth County Attorney's Office for review.
